DEVIL`S CHALLENGE - September 9, 2006

The Devil's Challenge is designed to put to the test all of your flyfishing knowledge and skills.

How the Challenge works

Two members per team. The Challenge takes place on the Diable River Fishing Sector during four hour fishing sessions. Each team draws a section of river and must fishing within that designated area. The team with the most accumulated points determined by a points system wins. Total prizes are 50% of the net registration fees and will be divided among the three top teams.

Challenge Rues

1. Each team is composed of two fishers.
2. Flies only may be used. No other lures, bait or scented material is permitted.
3. Any fly patterns tied using conventional methods and recognized fly tying material is acceptable.
4. Equipment will consist of fly rods from #3 to #8 weight with floating line.
5. Competitors must wear a hat, glasses and any other safety gear.
6. Each team will draw a section of river which it must fish inside.
7. Team members must catch their fish with both feet inside their designated sections.
8. All fish must be caught within the time of the Challenge.
9. All fish must be registered by a section controler on shore and released alive by the competitor in order to be counted.
10. No assistance from controlers or spectators will be permitted.
11. The point system is as follows:

trout (<12 inches)	5 points
trout(>12 + inches)	10 points
Bass	10 points
Pike	20 points
Carp	10 points
Other	1/2 point

12. The team with the most points will be declared the winner. If there is a tie the prize will be shared.
13. Breaking any of the rules will result in the disqualification of the team.
14. Any objection must be submitted to the organising committee within one hour of the end of the Challenge and accompanied by a fee of 10\$. All decisions by the organising committee will be final.
